Called to Go Forth

“One of those days Jesus went out to a mountainside to pray, and spent the night praying to God. When morning came, He called His disciples to Him and chose twelve of them, whom He also designated apostles.” Luke 6:12,13

The word apostle comes from the Greek word, “Apostolos,” meaning to be sent. These 12 apostles in our morning's text were called to go forth to proclaim the Gospel. In the same way, the Christian, the disciple, and the follower of Christ, in today's world is still called to go forth.
