From the Pastor’s Study

The Ever Near Risen Savior

“Now that same day, two of them were going to a village called Emmaus, about seven miles from Jerusalem. They were talking with each other about everything that had happened. As they talked and discussed these things with each other, Jesus Himself came up and walked along with them; but they were kept from recognizing Him.” Luke 24:13-16

In Hebrews 13:2 we read, “Do not forget to show hospitality to strangers for by doing so some people have shown hospitality to angels without knowing it.” Here in the above text, we find the two disciples on the road to Emmaus, doing one better than that. They were walking in the presence of the risen Jesus without knowing it. We read that, “they were kept from recognizing Him,” but that did not keep them from sharing their heart with this fellow traveler. They told Him of their grief over losing their friend and master and with that, their confusion over reports of His supposed resurrection from the dead earlier that day. It was only later, when this fellow traveler broke bread with them that they saw that He was in fact Jesus, risen from the dead.

In the same way, Jesus, our risen Savior walks with us in all of life’s circumstances even when we fail to recognize His presence. He is there with us in the good times and He is there with us in the difficult times of life as well. If you should doubt this wonderful truth, I would like to remind you of this risen Savior’s promise found in Matthew 28:20, “and surely, I am with you always, to the very end of the age.” In Jesus we find the perfect traveling companion and Lord due to the fact that we serve a risen Savior.

So, call out to Him, He is there. He sees, He hears, He cares, you are not alone. I like how the hymn, "He Lives," puts it in its refrain, "He lives, He lives, Christ Jesus lives today! May this blessed truth grant you the encouragement you need as you travel life's road before you, and at the same time empower you to tell others about this ever present risen Savior.

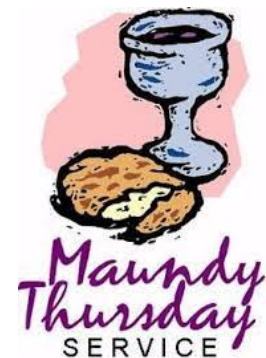


This service will be done by the Children/Youth.

The focus has always been on the Last Supper. For the disciples, it was to be an ordinary Passover meal that was the custom of the Jews on that night. But Christ would forever redefine the meal as the fulfillment of the Passover.

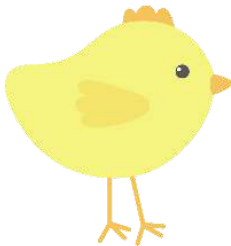

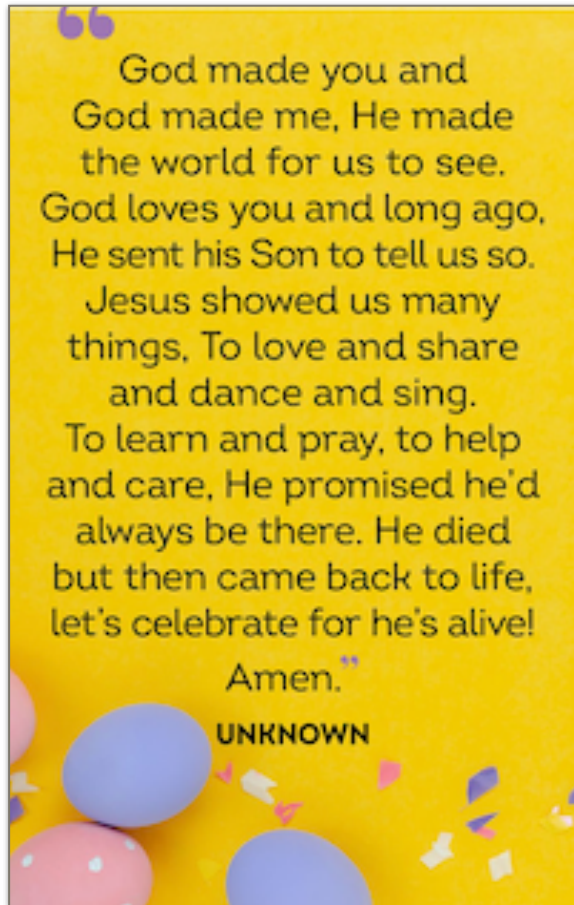
