Series: The Art of Biblical Friendship

Title: The Ministry of Presence

Text: Job 2:1-13; Romans 12:9-21

I. Introduction

In I Peter 2:21 we are told that we, “should follow in Jesus’ steps.” This same Jesus has come to be our friend as well as our Lord. Thus we are to follow His example of friendship. One of the aspects of His friendship is that of abiding with His people. In other words, His was a Divine Ministry of presence. This morning as we consider, “The Art of Biblical Friendship,” as mirrored in the person of Jesus, I’d like for us to reflect upon what is involved in the Ministry of Presence as seen in the initial act of Job’s friends.

SERMON NOTES

Series: The Art of Biblical Friendship

Title: First Things First

Text: Esther 4:6-17; Philippians 2:1-11

I. Introduction

The Bible is full of stories of individuals putting the needs of others ahead of themselves. In Esther's case, it was putting her life on the line to save her Jewish Countrymen and of course, in Jesus' case it was laying down his life for you and me. In each case, they put others ahead of themselves. As believers committed to the, "Art of Biblical Friendship," we are to do the same. This morning we shall be considering three practical ways of putting others ahead of self.

- A. First of all, we put others first when we choose to pray for them.

- B. Secondly, we put others first when we choose to forgive them.
