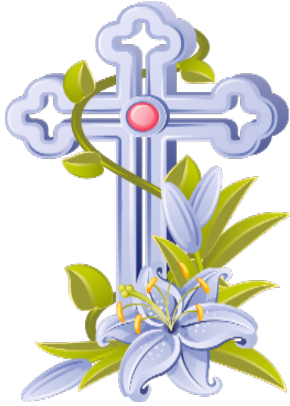
Please let me know if you would like to be a part of this recorder group. It's nothing formal or involved, just a group of folks who want to play recorders together, to the glory of God!
